

Cavalcade

Turf Type Tall Fescue



Cavalcade is a tough and beautiful turf type tall fescue that thrives under lower maintenance. It was selected for fine textured leaves, disease resistance, wear tolerance, and heat and drought tolerance.

Cavalcade exhibited excellent Seeding Vigor in the NTEP Trials*, it will quickly establish a dense lush dark green turf. Spring greenup was also among the best in the trial.

Cavalcade has excellent drought tolerance, it requires less water than bluegrass and ryegrass.

Disease resistance is superb, this tough turf type tall fescue has resistance to Brown Patch, Tred Thread, Typhula Blight, Fusarium Patch and Pythium Blight.

Planting Rate: 7 – 10 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.
 Germination: 9 – 14 days under normal conditions. For best results, seedlings should be kept watered until roots have been established.

Mowing height: 2 – 3"

Recommended for quality lawns, golf course roughs, parks, playgrounds, sports fields and other areas wanting quality low maintenance turf.
